This panel discussion brings together distinguished students to reflect on the journey of India since it gained independence in 1947. The conversation will explore the evolution of India into the world's largest democracy and its transformation into a major global player, while addressing the unique challenges and opportunities that have shaped its path.

The Department of Information Technology of SRKR Engineering College, through its CSI Student Branch, organized a Panel Discussion on Independent India on August 15, 2024, at Z.P.H.S, China Amiram. The event gathered a group of seven distinguished student participants, under the guidance of faculty coordinators Dr. I. Hemalatha and Dr. K. Kishore Raju, along with student coordinators Ch. Pavan Kumar and B. Gokul Venkat. The session took place from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM, aligning with India's Independence Day celebrations, providing a platform for deep reflection on India's journey since 1947.

The panel discussion focused on India's transition from its ancient civilization roots, through the colonial era, to its emergence as the world's largest democracy. Participants revisited India's historical milestones, highlighting the intellectual and spiritual achievements of ancient India, the impact of British colonial rule, and the sacrifices made during the freedom struggle by leaders like Mahatma Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru, and Subhas Chandra Bose. The discussion underlined how India's youthful energy, technological innovation, and strategic planning could shape its future trajectory toward inclusive and prosperous growth on the global stage.

It provided students and attendees with a comprehensive understanding of India's rich heritage, current challenges, and future opportunities. 

At the end of the Flowthon, projects were evaluated meticulously by the panel. Team VIT AP emerged as the winners, while The Chosen Team from Sasi Institute of Technology and Engineering secured the runners-up position. 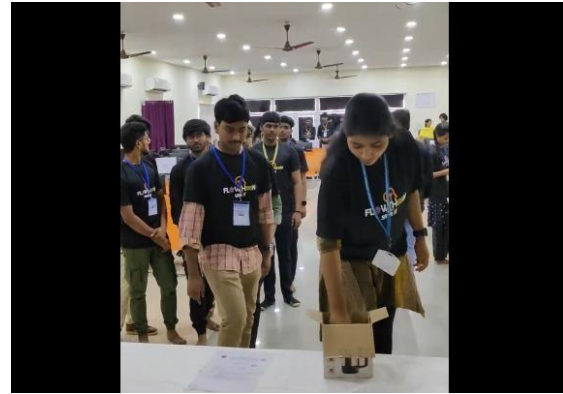
