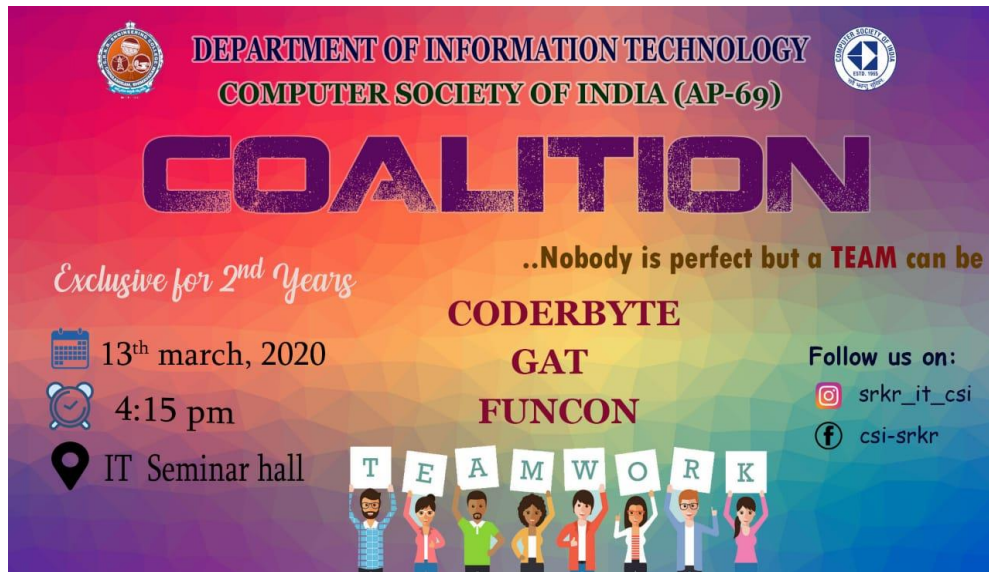

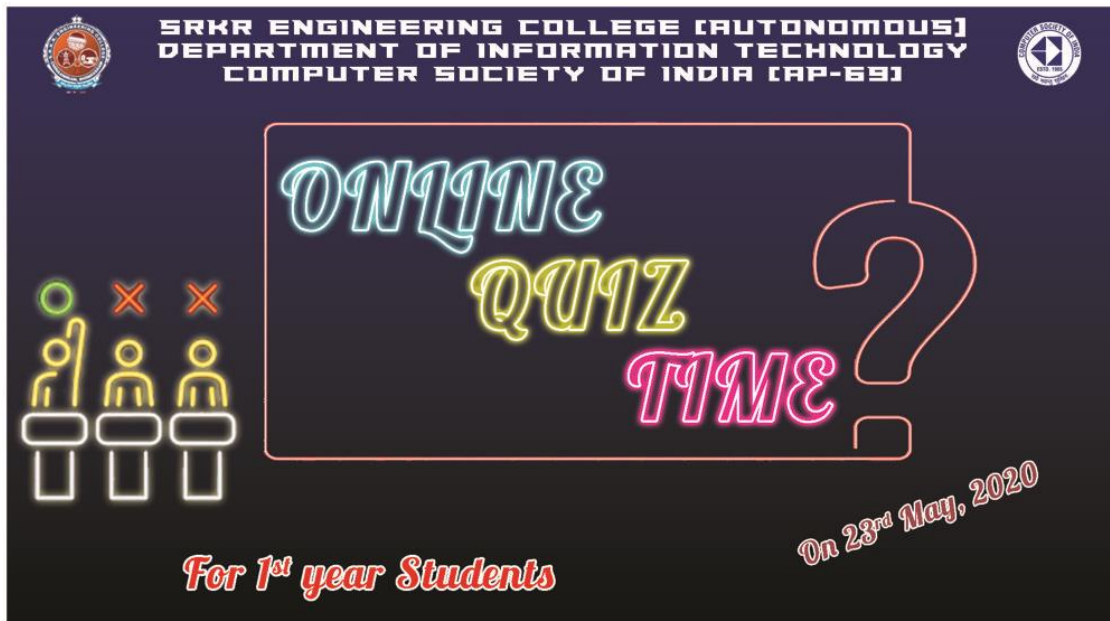

1. AGRICULTURE SECTOR:

As food is more important to Human Beings and it is not an easy task to monitor the soil moisture levels in the fields continuously. So many crops may die before they grow die to variant moisture levels. This problem can be resolved using the Soil Moisture Sensor and leads to a good solution.

SENSOR: SOIL MOISTURE SENSOR

Soil moisture sensors measure the volumetric water content in soil. Since the direct gravimetric measurement of free soil moisture requires removing, drying, and weighing of a sample, soil moisture sensors measure the volumetric water content indirectly by using some other property of the soil, such as electrical resistance, dielectric constant, or interaction with neutrons, as a proxy for the moisture content.

2. MEDICAL SECTOR:

Monitoring humidity and temperature values of the ICU room in the hospital is not an easy task. This problem can be resolved using DHT sensor and alarm rings when the humidity /temperature is not in safe range. Further improvement can be done like sending messages to the doctors in the hospital.

SENSOR: DHT SENSOR

The DHT11 is a basic, ultra low-cost digital temperature and humidity sensor. It uses a capacitive humidity sensor and a thermistor to measure the surrounding air, and spits out a digital signal on the data pin (no analog input pins needed).

3. INDUSTRIAL SECTOR:

A small fire in and around the industry may lead to largest explosion. It is more important to take care of the fire before explosion. This problem can be resolved using fire sensor and an alarm rings when the fire is detected.

SENSOR: FIRE SENSOR

Fire detectors sense one or more of the products or phenomena resulting from fire, such as smoke, heat, infrared and/or ultraviolet light radiation, or gas.

4. PARKING:

While entering the shopping complex, people may not know whether parking slot is available or not. This problem can be resolved by placing a display showing the number of slots available and if there is no slot available the gate is automatically closed restricting any vehicle to enter.

SENSOR: IR SENSOR

An infrared (IR) sensor is an electronic device that measures and detects infrared radiation in its surrounding environment. While measuring the temperature of each color of light, the temperature just beyond the red light was highest. IR is invisible to the human eye, as its wavelength is longer than that of visible light. Anything that emits heat (everything that has a temperature above around five degrees Kelvin) gives off infrared radiation.

5. FIRE STATION:

Fire may catch at any place in the city and the fire station does not know the place immediately. This problem can be resolved using Fire sensor at different places and when fire catches an alarm rings in the fire station and the respective place is displayed on OLED screen.

SENSOR: FIRE SENSOR

Fire detectors sense one or more of the products or phenomena resulting from fire, such as smoke, heat, infrared and/or ultraviolet light radiation, or gas.

6. U-TURN ACCIDENTS:

Accidents mostly occur in the U-turn areas. This problem can be resolved using IR sensor. If a vehicle is arriving on one side of U-turn then a red light is glown on other side so that the person can get alert and slow down the speed.

SENSOR: IR SENSOR

An infrared (IR) sensor is an electronic device that measures and detects infrared radiation in its surrounding environment. While measuring the temperature of each color of light, the temperature just beyond the red light was highest. IR is invisible to the human eye, as its wavelength is longer than that of visible light. Anything that emits heat (everything that has a temperature above around five degrees Kelvin) gives off infrared radiation.

7. SPORTS:

The automatic lights in the stadium will automatically turn on upon detecting light failure in between a match or a game. By using optical lightsensor we develop this model to consume conservation energy.

SENSOR: Optical Light Sensor

An optical sensor converts light rays into electronic signals. It measures the physical quantity of light and then translates it into a form that is readable by an instrument. An optical sensor is generally part of a larger system that integrates a source of light, a measuring device and the optical sensor.

8.HOME AUTOMATION:

The Automatic Room Lights using Arduino and IR Sensor is a simple project, where the lights in the room will automatically turn on upon detecting a human motion and stay turned on until the person has left or there is no motion.

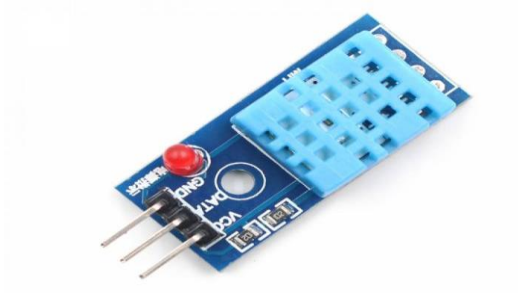
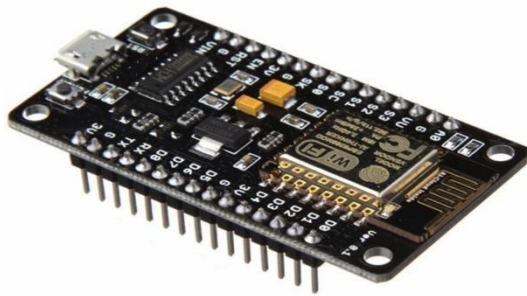
9.BASCULE BRIDGE:

A bascule bridge (also referred to as a drawbridge or a lifting bridge) is a moveable bridge with a counterweight that continuously balances a span, or leaf, throughout its upward swing to provide clearance for boat traffic. It may be single- or double-leafed.

SENSOR: ULTRA SONIC SENSOR

The sonic waves emitted by the transducer are reflected by an object and received back in the transducer. After having emitted the sound waves, the ultrasonic sensor will switch to receive mode. The time elapsed between emitting and receiving is proportional to the distance of the object from the sensor. Ultrasonic sensor are devices that use electrical– mechanical energy transformation to measure distance from the sensor to the target object. The HC-SR04 ultrasonic sensor uses sonar to determine distance to an object like bats or dolphins do. It provides 2cm to 400cm of non-contact measurement functionality with a ranging accuracy that can reach up to 3mm. Each HC-SR04 module includes an ultrasonic transmitter, a receiver and a control circuit. There are only four pins that you need to worry about on the HCSR04: VCC (power), Trig (Trigger), Echo (Receiver) and GND (Ground).
