The Grand finale of the Software competition titled Smart India Hackathon-2019,organised by the ministry of Human Resource Management(MHRD) and the All India Council for Technical Education(AICTE, New Delhi). In 48 nodal centers across the country Smart India Hackathon-2019 is led by the AICTE in 3000 colleges with participation of more than a lakh students across the country, from which 24 to 36 teams selected for each nodal centre in the country which covers all states. This event is a initiative to motivate the students with a right platform to identify and address the problems related to the society, different ministries and industries had come up with the solutions for problems.

The SIH-2019 competition was held at Nodal Centre SRKR Engineering College, Bhimavaram, Andhra Pradesh, On March 1,2,&3rd 2019. In S.R.K.R Engineering College nodal centre – Six problem statements of three industries (SKF India Limited [4],VANDARLANDE[1] and PLEZMA[1]) are allocated.

Three Industries :

1. SKF India Limited - Four Problem Statements
2. VANDARLANDE - One Problem Statement
3. PLEZMA - One Problem Statement

The problem statements are

1. Automated Visual Inspection Of Oil Components.(SKF)
2. Zero Defect Manufacturing Of Suppliers(SKF).
- 3.Create an Augmented reality based 3D build and assembly instruction app for cardboard models organization (PLEZMA).
4. Using AI to implement slotting, picking SM3 organization (VANDERLANDE)
5. Real time info: Suppliers supply chain planning (SKF).
6. Automated system for material return from customers (SKF)

Totally 24 short listed teams from eight different States (New Delhi , Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra , Pondichery, Bihar , West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh , Uttar Pradesh) are allotted to S.R.K.R Engineering College Nodal Centre.

Each team comprises of six students and one or two mentors who will be given training before the team attempt to work on finding a solution. The mentors will only give guidance to their teams and the team will work on finding the solution within 36 hours.

S.R.K.R Engineering College taken care about receiving all teams coming from 8 states and industry experts . Arranged vehicles at Vijayawada & Rajahmundry airports and Vijayawada , Rajahmundry , Tadepalligudem , Bhimavaram Railway & Bus stations. Two buses and 10 cabs are arranged exclusively for transportation.

The Smart India Hackathon-2019 Arena was inaugurated by Principal Dr.G.P.Saradhi Varma on 1st march,2019 at 1 P.M for team registrations. All teams reached on 28th February 2019 & 1st March 2019 and registered on 1st March 2019. The team registrations process including App registrations closed by last 24th team at 11.30 pm on 1st March 2019. The Nodal Centre Head approved all teams registrations through App on 2nd March 2019.

The Smart India Hackathon-2019 Grand Finale summary captures a two-day programme of AICTE-MHRD Software edition of 36 hours hackathon competition and evaluation by Jury members at the nodal centre which took place on 2nd & 3rd march 2019 in S.R.K.R Engineering College , Bhimavaram , Andhra Pradesh. The event brought together key officials of AICTE , MHRD , JNTUK, Government of Andhra Pradesh and experts from industry . It also provided a valuable networking opportunity and set the stage for Project /product / coding Presentations .
